EPA's Office of Inspector General (OIG) plans to begin preliminary research for an audit of grants awarded under EPA's Science to Achieve Results (STAR) program. The objectives for the preliminary research phase of the audit are:

- 1) Is EPA effectively monitoring activities of STAR grant recipients?
- 2) What actions does EPA take to ensure that no research misconduct is associated with any of the grant activities?

We plan to interview officials within the National Center for Environmental Research and the Office of Grants and Debarment. We also plan to interview the grants specialists and project officers assigned to a random sample of STAR grants. We will review grant and project officer files, guidance documents, and previous U.S. Government Accountability Office and EPA OIG reports that are relevant to our preliminary research. At the end of the preliminary research phase, we will decide whether additional work is warranted and whether the objectives should be modified.

We will contact your audit coordinators within the next few days to arrange a mutually agreeable time for a kick-off meeting to discuss the assignment. At the meeting we will answer any questions you may have about the assignment process, reporting procedures, methods we will

use to gather and analyze data, and what you should expect during the course of the project. To assist in conducting the assignment, we request that you provide the following information at the kick-off meeting:

- 1. A list of STAR grants with project end dates in fiscal years 2012 and 2013.
- 2. The Agency-wide scientific integrity policy.
- 3. The results of any Office of Research and Development office-wide risk assessments related to STAR grants.
- 4. A key contact list for the Office of Research and Development and Office of Grants and Debarment.
