**PURPOSE of the REPORT:**

To provide specific oversight data for ARRA contracts, grant, loans, and entitlement programs. The reports will be consolidated and used to update the Universe of Recovery Act Funds graphic on Recovery.gov.

**SUBMISSION:**

Only those IGs with ARRA Entitlement Programs and/or who report conviction data will need to complete and submit the additional template. This report should be submitted (as a separate file) along with the ARRA Monthly report, which is due five working days after the end of each month. The file should be named using the OIG Name, Reporting Month, Title of Report, and Date of Submission (e.g., USDA OIG October 2011 ARRA Oversight Activity By Category 110711.xls). The file should be saved as an Excel 97-2003 Workbook file. Send the report file to: RecoveryUpdates@ratb.gov.

# OIG Recovery Act Oversight Activities

## INSTRUCTIONS:

**Reporting OIG** - Pick from list of OIGs required to report on Recovery Act activity.

**Month Ending Date** - Enter the final day of the month (e.g., 10/31/2011) regardless of the day of the week submitted.

**Monthly Report Tie Total** - Enter the Active Investigations and Cumulative Convictions (Judgments, Settlements, Pleas), data as reported on the corresponding month's ARRA Report.

**Infrastructure** - Enter the number of Active Investigations, Cumulative Convictions, etc., and Total Monetary Loss for ARRA contract, grant, and loan programs (Infrastructure).

**Entitlements** - Enter the number of Active Investigations, Cumulative Convictions, etc., and Total Monetary Loss for ARRA entitlement programs (see list of entitlement programs provided).

**Check Total** - Sum of the data entered into cells in the Infrastructure and Entitlements Columns. Note: The sum for Active Investigations and Cumulative Convictions, etc. should match the corresponding cell in the Monthly Report Tie-Total Column. These cells are formula driven, no input is necessary.

## Terminology

**Infrastructure** - term used to describe ARRA federal contract, grant, and loan programs.

**Entitlements** - one or more of the ARRA funded programs provided in this workbook as identified by the applicable Recovery Agency.

**Total \$ Loss** - refers to the total ARRA \$ loss to the agency related to the fraudulent case. This amount is usually what is reported to the US Attorney's office. It is the total ARRA amount associated with the case but is not always the actual settlement or recovery.
